

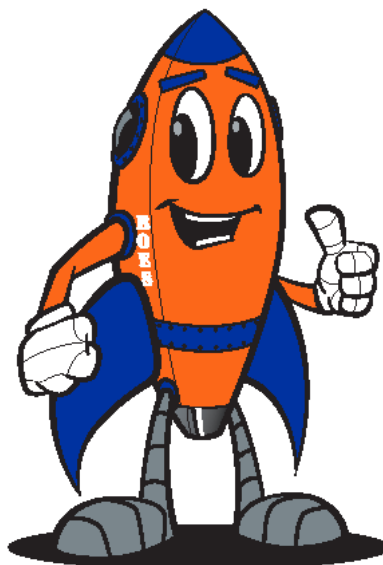
Title 1 Information

- ◆ ROSA is school-wide Title 1.
- ◆ Currently, we have approximately 53% of students who qualify for reduced priced meals.
- ◆ This year we received an additional \$401,707 from the federal government to be used for Title 1 purposes.
- ◆ All ROSA students benefit from the resources purchased with Title 1 funds.
- ◆ Our Title 1 funds support:
 - ⇒ Lead Interventionists to oversee reading and math interventions to students for improving academic skills; support for core instruction
 - ⇒ Flex Teacher to support instruction
 - ⇒ Parent Involvement Funding
 - ⇒ 5 Tutor(s) for academic instruction
 - ⇒ Contracted services with artists in residence
