2021-2022 Course Registration

Course Registration in 4 Steps!

Step 1: Check your PowerSchool login. If you can't get logged in, ask one of your teachers to reset your account login.

Step 2: Review all the Registration Modules in the Student Services Canvas Page

Step 3: Log in to PowerSchool between **January 25th and February 15th** to complete your online course registration.

PowerSchool will **CLOSE** on **February 15th!**

Step 4: Check Canvas for a new “assignment”. Your Counselor may send you a document to complete if you selected one of the following course types: AP, CCP, NCVPS or Honors.

Transcript Mail-Out

Check your mailbox the week of January 31st

You should receive a copy of your Unofficial Transcript in the mail.

How to Read It:

-Check for your name, current grade level and student ID number

-**Check for Credits Earned at the top of the page:** This includes your Fall 2020 credits. (You earn credits for courses you take and pass.)

-**Check Cum Weighted GPA:** This is the grade-point average earned for each high school level class you've completed.

-**Check all classes you've taken:** This will help you identify which classes to sign up for 2021-2022.

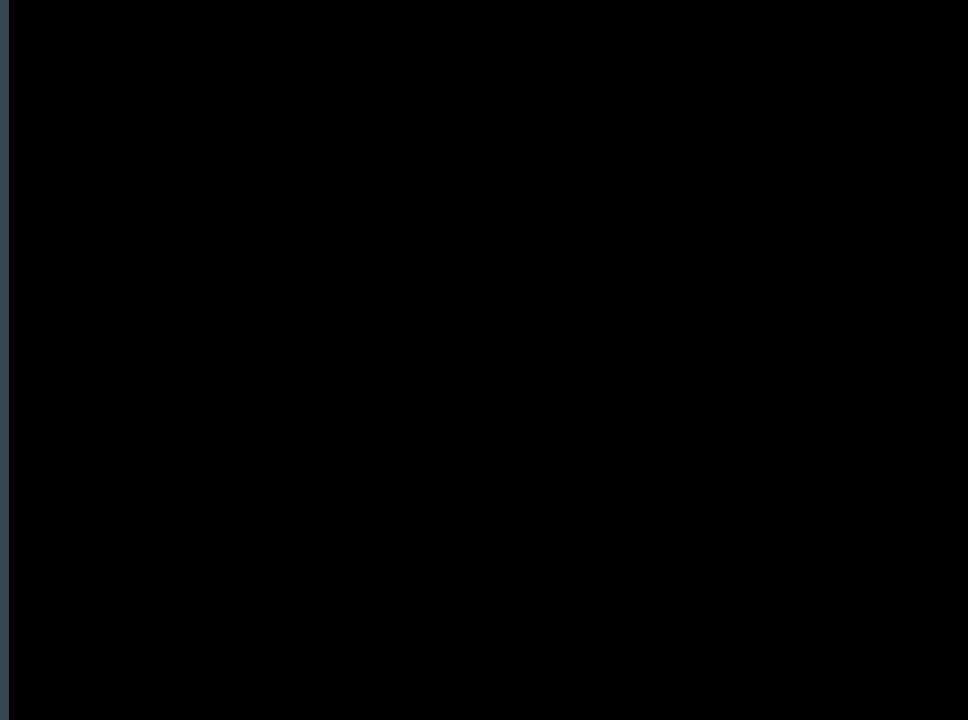

Things to do before completing course registration online:

1. Make sure you know your login information.
2. Review and complete the registration modules in the Student Services Canvas Course.
3. Login to PowerSchool and view your Historical Grades. This will help you determine the right level course for you.
4. Talk with teachers and parents/guardians before making your final selections.
