What is the difference between social media and online learning platforms (Canvas, Microsoft Teams, etc.)?

- * Online Learning Systems are focused on **LEARNING!**
- * A place to get notes, receive and submit assignments, have discussions about our specific content, and review.
- * Canvas & Microsoft Teams are places where we communicate about our content and our classes.

What IS ok to add in online learning platforms?

- * Questions about specific assignments, assessments, or topics
- * Appropriate and relevant comments during live meetings or canvas discussions



What IS NOT ok to add in online learning platforms?

- * Random or disruptive questions or comments that are not related or helpful to what we are trying to learn or do.
- * Disrespectful, rude or hurtful comments
- * The answers to assignments, quizzes, tests, etc.
- * Memes, pictures, videos, etc.

Reminders:

- * School dress code still stands during live video meetings.
- * Minimize emojis and texting acronyms in typed content.
- * Off task comments keep all of us from our free time. Stay on task.
- * If it's inappropriate for school, it's inappropriate for online learning systems.
