CCHS Prom Dress Code 2018-19

All students in attendance at CCHS' Prom are required to abide by the following dress code. If you have a concern about your outfit, please address it with either Mrs. Smith or Mrs. Foster prior to purchasing it and/or prior to prom. You do not want to have any surprises or be turned away upon arrival at prom.

- 1. Prom is a formal event and students should dress accordingly; tuxedo's and evening gowns are appropriate formal wear.
- 2. No formal wear should be excessively revealing.
- 3. Plunging necklines are not allowed. Necklines should not go below bra line. A sweetheart neckline IS appropriate.
- 4. Slit on a dress should not be higher than mid-thigh.
- 5. Two-piece dresses should not show more than 3 inches of mid-section skin.
- 6. Short dresses are allowed but should not be more than 4 inches above the knee.
- 7. The back of the dress may be open, but bare skin should not be exposed below the waist.
- 8. Students cannot wear denim, this is not formal attire.
- 9. Shorts are not appropriate, this is not formal attire.
- 10. A jacket/coat and tie are required.
- 11. If your attire does not meet dress code you will be asked to leave, change, pin or cover with a wrap or shall. This change would be required to stay in place for the entire length of prom.
