<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Middle School</u></p> <p>➤ Solid Gray Collared Shirt</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>High School</u></p> <p>➤ Solid Black Collared Shirt</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● No patterns, pictures, or words ● No logos larger than a quarter ● Must be long enough to remain tucked in at all times ● No visible cleavage <p>Solid color pull over sweatshirt may be worn over top uniform shirt</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Sweater must be black, white, or gray (Solid color with no patterns) ● Sweater cannot have buttons, zippers, buckles, or shawls <p>Solid color undershirt may be worn underneath collared uniform shirt</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Must be solid black, white or gray ● No Buttons, zippers, or buckles 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Must be solid khaki or black in color ● No jeans or jean materials are permitted. (Pants with denim ridges and rivets on pocket corners are deemed jeans and are prohibited) ● Long pants, Capri Pants, or knee length shorts may be worn. ● No joggers or any type with elastic at ankles ● Must have belt loops ● Properly worn at the waist (No Sagging) ● No tight fitting pants such as spandex, tights, or leggings may be worn as pants ● No holey, slashed, or frayed pants ● No Cut-off pants/shorts 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Shoes</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Must be athletic shoes or sneakers ● Can only be White, Black, Gray, or combination of those colors ● No other colors are permitted ● No open toed shoes ● No boots of any kind ● No Bedroom shoes <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Socks</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Must be White, Black, Gray, or a combination of those colors ● No other colors are permitted <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Belts</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Leather or burlap material ● Must be black, brown, white or gray ● No oversized buckles or spikes 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● No garments may be worn under a student's uniform that could be considered outerwear. This includes, but is not limited to: athletic shorts, jogging pants, pajama bottoms, etc. ● No hats, caps, head coverings, hair curlers, picks, combs, hairbrushes or sunglasses ● No jackets or hoodies are allowed to be worn in the building ● No book bags, containers, pouches, or purses. ● PE clothes may be brought in a plastic grocery bag only ● All keys must be kept in the student's pocket ● Tattoos must be covered at all times ● No jewelry is allowed, including but not limited to: earrings, tongue/nose piercings, bracelets, necklaces, watches, etc. ● Students may not carry more than \$20 on their person at anytime

Cell phones, MP3 players, and all other electronic devices are prohibited on school grounds. If confiscated, a parent must come to the school to retrieve the item and it will not be returned to the student for any reason. Do not bring any expensive items to school (tennis shoes, etc.); if you do and they are stolen, the school has no responsibility to replace.

Student must conform to dress code from the time that they arrive on campus until the time they depart (leave campus).

Any open or inappropriate food/drink items will be confiscated and thrown away at search.

The principal or search staff will make final decisions regarding a student's attire. NO EXCEPTIONS will be made to the Opportunity School dress code policy. Students will NOT be allowed to attend class if appropriate clothing is not worn. Students wearing inappropriate clothing will be required to call their parent/guardian to bring appropriate attire. Repeat offenses are subject to disciplinary action. Any type of attire or appearance (hairstyle, etc.) that interferes with the educational process will not be allowed.
