



Student Teacher/Intern Guidelines

Due to COVID-19

(all regular student teacher requirements still apply)

Clinical Observations: prior to senior year

- Not considered essential for attending in person and not assigned by Human Resources
- EPP students work with their EPP to find alternate ways to meet requirements (i.e. videos of teachers)

Practicum: semester during senior year in which student teachers are assigned to cooperating teacher for observations

- Not considered essential for attending in person and assigned by Human Resources
- Will be provided access to participate remotely with cooperating teacher
- Will be provided a virtual orientation with relevant board policies to include 7320 Technology Acceptable Use Policy, 7310 Staff-Student Relations, 1310-4002 Parental Involvement, 4700 Student Records, 4205 Internet Safety, 4318 Use of Electronic Devices, 7340 Employee Dress & Appearance, 7205 Standards of Professional Conduct, 7335 Employee Use of Social Media and Electronic Communication, 7230 Prohibition Against Discrimination, Harassment, and Bullying, 7240 Drug Free and Alcohol Free Workplace, 7300 Staff Responsibilities, etc.
- Will receive a CCS email account and access to Curriculum Learning Management (CANVAS)

Student Teaching/Student Services Interns (Counselors, Social Workers, Related Services): Fall or Spring Semester full-time with cooperating teacher.

- Considered essential for attending in person and remotely with their assigned cooperating teacher. This is conditional upon appropriate social distancing in the classroom, PPE, and health screening requirements at work site. Assignments made by HR and principal/supervisor.
- Will be provided a virtual orientation with relevant board policies to include 7320 Technology Acceptable Use Policy, 7310 Staff-Student Relations, 1310-4002 Parental Involvement, 4700 Student Records, 4205 Internet Safety, 4318 Use of Electronic Devices, 7340 Employee Dress & Appearance, 7205 Standards of Professional Conduct, 7335 Employee Use of Social Media and Electronic Communication, 7230 Prohibition Against Discrimination, Harassment, and Bullying, 7240 Drug Free and Alcohol Free Workplace, 7300 Staff Responsibilities, etc.
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NOTE: Should follow [Home Health Screening Requirements](#) and not report in person if sick. Will be screened at district school.

University Supervisors: (Visitors not allowed on site)

- Observe/evaluate the asynchronous teaching and learning activities provided by the student teacher to the students.
- Utilize a program such as GoReact for student teacher observations (parental permission required).
