Schedule Changes

CCS establishes a summertime date each year for all schedule change request to be made. Those requests are made through the MPHS Student Services Department. After that deadline, schedule changes are only made due to pupil balancing or administrative error. If a student drops a class once the term has begun, it is only with the Principal's approval and the grade of "WF" will be on the report card and transcript. It will be averaged into the overall GPA as a failing grade.

Earning Credits & Attendance

Cabarrus County High Schools are on a block system. There are two terms with four courses each term lasting 80 minutes per class. The State Department of Instruction requires seat time to earn a credit. As a result, if a student misses more than 13 days in a course, credit will be withheld.

Read Below & Sign:

We recommend that you communicate with your child's teachers and/or school counselor when selecting courses for the 2021-22 school year. Consider courses that will provide your child a challenging and successful education experience. Students who score at Levels I or II on one or both EOG test may be subject to administrative schedule changes for academic reasons. Students who score V on EOG are required to take Honors level courses in those content areas. We have carefully considered the above course selections and understand that some courses we have chosen require a year's commitment. We understand that dropping a course after the term begins will result in a grade of "WF" for the year in the course is dropped.
