  2. *Central Cabarrus High School's Scholarship Committee will meet and select two students that will represent Central Cabarrus High School. These two students will be given additional application information to complete.*
  3. *Please note that nominees for the Park Scholarship must submit a completed application for Undergraduate Admissions, along with a transcript, to the Office of Undergraduate Admissions at N.C. State as soon as possible but not later than November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019.*
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4. *Students who are not chosen as Central Cabarrus High School nominees may self endorse by November 1<sup>st</sup> deadline. Attention Seniors: North Carolina State University has announced that the Park Scholarship Application is open.

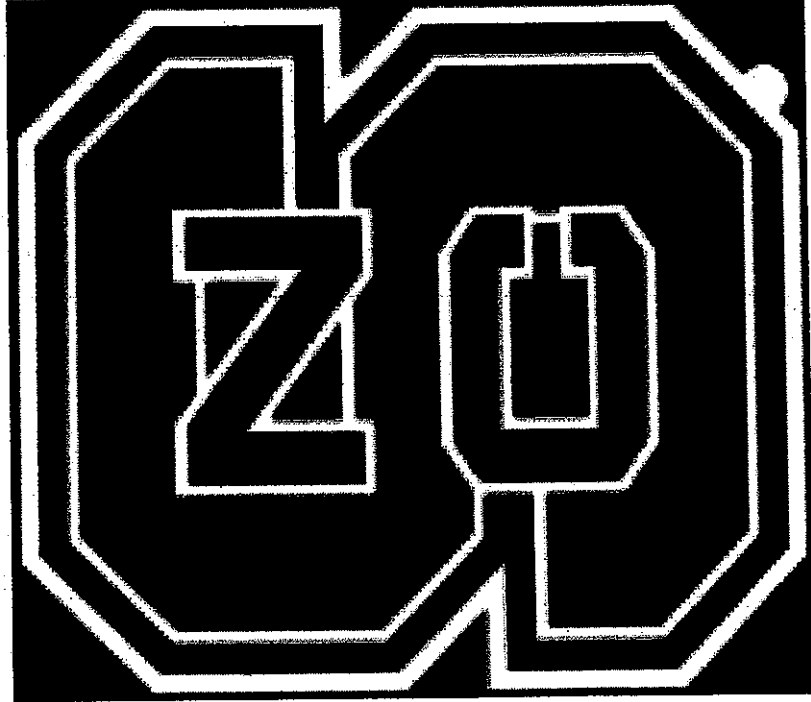

***U.N.C. – Chapel Hill***

To be eligible for the **Morehead-Cain Scholarship** a candidate must show evidence of outstanding achievement in the following four criteria: Leadership – Scholarship – Moral Force of Character – Physical Vigor. Only **four** seniors from Central Cabarrus High School will be selected to be nominated by the school for this prestigious award. Other students that are not nominated by the school are able to apply directly for this award.

**School Nominee:**

Those students wishing to apply to be nominated by the school must complete the attached forms and return them to Ms. Palmer in Student Services

**no later than 2:30 pm on September 20th.** Applicants must also submit copies of their SAT, ACT and AP test scores with their preliminary applications. The Scholarship Committee will select four students to be school nominees. School nominees usually rank in the top 10% of the senior class.

Please be sure to apply under the correct section (“You are a senior at a secondary school in North Carolina and you wish to apply directly for the Morehead-Cain”).
