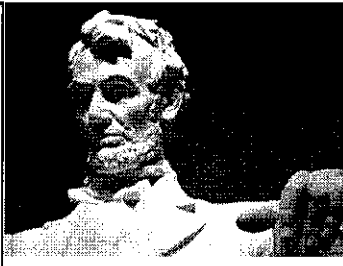


**10<sup>th</sup> Grade Trip**

**Where:** Washington, DC

**When:** April 7-9, 2020

**What:** Students will be able to visit the Nation’s Capital and see first-hand the things they learned in Civics, American History, and English II. See the itinerary for trip details.

**Cost:** \$355 for students (4 to a room) – This includes meals and lodging.  
 \$633 for parent chaperones (for a single room)

I understand that we will be responsible for a \$55 non-refundable deposit by November 4<sup>th</sup> to secure a spot. If a cancellation is made prior to February 1<sup>st</sup>, any money paid over the \$75 deposit will be refunded. February 1<sup>st</sup> and later, no cancellations can be accepted. Total cost of trip will be your responsibility.

**Fundraising:** Students will have the opportunity to participate in fundraisers to reduce their cost. Amounts collected prior to the deposit can be put towards the deposit amount. All money raised by the student will be applied to their balance.

**Scholarships:** There are a limited number of partial scholarships available for students who cannot afford the entire cost of the trip. Students that receive scholarships are responsible for the balance of the cost. The expectation is that every student attends this trip and we will work with families to create a workable payment plan. To receive a scholarship, students will need to fill out the bottom portion of the permission slip and participate in our school-wide fundraiser.

**Forms:** All forms must be filled out and returned by November 4<sup>th</sup>.
