Scholarship 2020 Application Criteria and Information

Purpose:

The Salvation Army Women's Auxiliary Scholarship was established to recognize three graduating seniors in Kannapolis City, Cabarrus and Stanly County who are wishing to extend their education.

Scholarship Criteria:

1. Must be a citizen (or legal resident) of the United States and a current resident of Kannapolis City, Cabarrus or Stanly County.
2. Must have applied to attend an accredited college or technical school in N.C.
3. Must plan on attending full time. (At least 12 credit hours)
4. Must sign a photo release.

Qualifications:

1. Have a need of **financial** assistance.
2. Have a history of volunteerism in the community
3. Have commendable character traits.
4. Have definite goals.

Funding:

An amount of \$1,000 will be applied towards tuition, books, and fees, which will be paid directly to the recipient's school of choice.

Application Procedures:

1. Complete the application form.
2. Complete a personal essay. (Include area of study and reason for financial assistance)
3. Attach a copy of your high school transcript.
4. Include two letters of recommendation.
 - *One from a person knowledgeable of your character.
 - *One from a person knowledgeable of your academic achievements.
5. Interview with the Salvation Army Women's Auxiliary Scholarship Committee if required.
6. The application and all supporting documents must be complete and postmarked no later than **Tuesday, April 14, 2020**
