- **Why:** Provide support for students negatively impacted by COVID-19
 - **Who:** Kindergarten - 12th Grade Students who are ***at risk for academic failure and grade retention*** and ***students on the EC Extended Content Standards*** (Abilities & Possibilities; Structured Learning; Living & Learning) who have been Plan C this year
 - Invitations sent April 23rd
 - Transportation & Meals Provided
 - Additional students will be served if space is available
 - Contact your child's school to add your name to the waitlist – students will be placed as space becomes available
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Summer Jump Start EC - FAQ

- **Q: What other services are available if my child is not invited to Summer Jump Start?**
 - **A:** If your child is not making progress on IEP goals or has experienced significant regression that has not been recouped since return to face-to-face instruction, please call an IEP team meeting to discuss Extended School Year, or possible changes to the IEP.
 - **Q: My child missed some IEP services during the 2020-2021 school year. What should I do?**
 - **A:** Call an IEP team meeting so that the team can address make-up or additional services.
 - **Q: Will my child's IEP be followed at Summer Jump Start?**
 - **A:** Jump Start is not an extension of the school year. All IEP accommodations and modifications will be followed. A Summer Success Plan will be created and shared with parents that will outline any Specially Designed Instruction or related service that is necessary to participate in the Summer Jump Start program.
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
