Students will then register for classes using the selections listed in PowerSchool with help from their counselor. ALL students MUST return a signed registration form or registration could be delayed.

If needed, MPHS allows schedule corrections for the upcoming year during the summer only. Those dates will be printed on the student schedule they receive in the Spring. The only changes what will be made are to correct administrative errors to a schedule. If a student drops a class once the term has begun, the grade of "WF" will be recorded on the report card and transcript factoring into the GPA as a failing grade.

Earning Credits & Attendance

Cabarrus County High Schools are on a block system. There are two terms with four courses each term lasting 80 minutes per class. The State Department of Instruction requires seat time to earn a credit. As a result, if a student misses more than 13 days in a course, credit will be withheld.

Students may not drop classes or make changes after the Schedule Correction window (June/July). Schedule correction requests are accepted online and must be submitted by the established deadline. The only changes made after the deadline are those due to school error and student balancing. If you desire a flex period, you must provide your own transportation and have a signed SENIOR REQUEST FOR OFF CAMPUS PERIOD on file. You must pass 3 out of 4 courses to be athletically eligible.

Students will not be removed from Honors/AP courses once the semester begins.
