ONLINE REGISTRATION: Students will register online through PowerSchool starting the day of their grade’s Group Advisement Assembly. Log into the student or parent portal anytime between now & your grade-level’s deadline (together with your parents), choose eight courses & at least two alternates, and you are done with the first part of registering for your classes for 2019-20! Counselors will review your course selections, give you feedback during Counselor Consultations (in February & March), and allow you to make adjustments at that time if needed. Students who do not choose courses thru PowerSchool by the deadline will have their courses chosen for them by their counselors.

POWERSCHOOL ACCESS: If you do not know your PowerSchool username & login, see one of your teachers to claim your account (if you have not already done so). Those who do not have computer access may visit the S3 Office or library before or after school or during lunch.

CHOOSING YOUR COURSES: You are responsible for your course selections. You need to choose very wisely & take the best courses to meet graduation requirements & appropriately challenge yourself in preparation for college & career. All students must choose eight courses & at least two alternates. You are strongly advised to consult with parents & teachers before making your selections. Counselors will be available for consultation during lunch periods in the Commons Tuesdays & Thursdays thru most of December and January. **Choose alternates wisely**, as you may get one of those courses on your schedule.

COURSES WITH SEPARATE APPLICATIONS: *Courses in italics require an application. Applications open February 1 and are due by February 15 (unless otherwise specified by the teacher of that course).* Application courses are **grayed** in the first/check column. Applications will be available thru the S3 Registration 2019 webpage by **February 1**. See instructions in PowerSchool for how to handle application-based courses while registering in PowerSchool (ex. CCP (dual enrollment), Flexing for seniors, Broadcasting II/III/IV, Yearbook, Leadership, Performing Arts Proficient or Advanced, etc.). CCP & NCVPS Applications are due March 1.

SCHEDULE CHANGES: Students may make changes when they meet individually with counselors in February/March or during the schedule change window in May. However, it is extremely important to **choose your courses wisely now** because doing so gives you the **best chance of getting the classes you most want**. Schedule changes will be accepted from **May 1 - 15**. There are no exceptions to the **May 15** deadline except in cases of school error. As always, changes must be submitted via the online schedule change form on the S3 website. **The last day to submit schedule changes is May 15!**

SCHEDULE ADJUSTMENTS: Students who experience a change in course eligibility due to final course grades for classes taken this year will have until June 30 to advise the school that a schedule adjustment is needed (ex. move from Honors to regular or vice versa). The way to do this is to email Mr. Lowry at mark.lowry@cabarrus.k12.nc.us; he will assess your request & pass it along to your counselor if the change is approved. No course level adjustments will be considered after the June 30 deadline, so please plan accordingly. Please note that this is not the same as changing your mind about a class; it is simply changing levels in the same course due to new information (your final grade). The last day to request a schedule adjustment is **June 30**.

BLENDED COURSES: We offer a variety of blended courses where the course content is presented both in a seated course and through the instructor’s Canvas course online. CMHS administration reserves the right to schedule students in a blended section if the student has chosen that course.

HONORS & AP COURSES: The recommended guideline for choosing Honors & AP Courses is an “A” in the regular course or a “B” in the Honors course that precedes it. Students should not jump into AP without having had an Honors course first. Students who do not meet the guideline will not be allowed to sign up for Honors or AP courses without completing a **Waiver Form** (Registration 2019 webpage). Students are advised against taking more than two AP combinations per year. Those who wish to take a high number of AP courses during high school should strategically plan so they can spread those courses out over 10th – 12th grades to prevent an AP overload in any one year. You are advised to consult with your teachers before selecting Honors or AP courses.

YEARLONG AP COMBINATIONS: Please see insert inside this packet or download copy from Registration 2019 webpage.

NCVPS, CCP & CROSS-ENROLLMENT COURSES: You may be interested in taking courses through **NCVPS** (North Carolina Virtual Public Schools), Rowan-Cabarrus Community College’s **CCP** (Career & College Promise) program or courses offered at other Cabarrus County high schools. Counselors will discuss these during Group Advisement. Check the Registration 2019 webpage for specific instructions on how to complete separate registration responsibilities for these types of courses. Expect significant changes in eligibility and enrollment for CCP classes compared to last year. CCP & NCVPS Applications are due **March 1**.

ADVANCED CTE COURSES: Preference in some very popular advanced CTE courses will be given to students closest to graduation – particularly if the course is needed to complete a CTE Career Cluster (ex. Foods I, Foods II, Health Science II, etc.).
