

Advanced Placement & Optimal Academic Rigor in High School

The following AP courses are available as course selections. Students should carefully consider their overall commitments (school, work, athletics, clubs, activities, family time, friends, recreation, etc.) while choosing the most rigorous courses for their ability as part of their holistic planning for college and career readiness. Students not yet ready for AP or looking for additional rigor may add Career & College Promise (CCP) classes as well.

Rigor is important. A little bit of stress is motivational. Too much of a challenge or stress can overwhelm. Choose wisely, with the advisement of your parents, teachers and counselors, while carefully considering the context and scope of your commitments for next year.
