**ALEKS:**

Students will be expected to complete a unit assignment in ALEKS for every unit. The questions will be relevant to the material covered in class for that unit. It will be due by the end of the day on review day for each unit. It will be graded on accuracy and count as a quiz grade.

**Expectations:**

- You are expected to come to class each day prepared. When the tardy bell rings, you are to be in your assigned seat, working on the warm-up activity.
- Please have a notebook just for Math III. All work MUST be done in PENCIL!
- It is expected that you will practice our in-class material every day. Time in class will be given for this, but it is expected you will finish outside of class if necessary. At the end of each unit, there will be an online assessment based on practice questions which will count as your homework grade for the unit.
- Remember to make up all work missed when you are absent. If you are absent on a quiz or test day, you will be expected to make it up the day you come back. You will have one day for each missed day to make up work.
- Our class time is VERY important. Please limit your restroom breaks to emergencies.
- Cheating on any assignment, test, or quiz will result in an initial 0 and office referral but an opportunity will be given to retest/complete for half credit.
- Cell phones will not be tolerated during instructional time unless specifically expressed. The first offense will be a warning. The second offense will result in the phone being put in a paper bag on the student's desk for the class period. Any attempt to remove the phone from this bag will result in confiscation of the device for the remainder of the day.
- Late work will not be accepted unless there are extenuating circumstances.

- Students will be allowed to remediate ALL tests for half credit back to the original grade. Some time in class will be given for this, but if that is not enough, students will need to schedule time before or after school to work on this.
- In addition, if the test grade is higher than the quiz grade, the test grade can replace the quiz grade. This only applies to the test grade before remediation.
