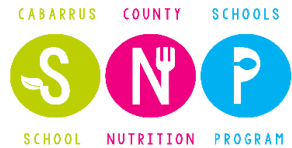

In Community Eligibility Schools (CES), applications are no longer collected. CEP eligibility is determined by the ISP on April 1 of the preceding school year and is elected in 4-year cycles. The number in this column reflects the ISP on April 1, 2019. The current multiplier set by USDA is 1.6.
